My Costume Design course includes drawing and rendering styles that teach the students to understand the necessary steps for creating a realized costume design for the stage, including research methodologies for determining script analysis, character psychology, and historical dress and costume. I significantly increased the value and benefit of this class

beyond the introductory costume design classes offered in most BA/BS theatre programs by moving the commonly included costume construction aspects into a separate class, allowing more time and attention for the research, analysis, and renderings essential to effective costume design. Developed in 2008.

Theatre Major course development: THRE 1342 Costume Technology

My Costume Technology course teaches the basics of costume construction for the theatre. The class begins with hand sewing commonly used in the costume shop, then progresses through machine sewing and the patterning and construction of a historical garment. I developed this class to focus on costume construction skills and essential techniques, but which are often inadequately addressed when bundled with design as is common at most BA/BS theatre programs. As this is a required class for all our theatre and theatre education majors, its improvement in detail and depth not only distinguishes WT's theatre program, but also ensures that the program's graduates are well-equipped to create costumes for productions in all kinds of settings. Developed in 2007.

Online course development: THRE-1310-70 Introduction to Theatre

Using my face to face course as a base, I created a summer online version of Introduction to Theatre. Students were assessed through discussion boards, quizzes, play reading tests, and image research projects. Developed 2018.

Student Professional development course design: THRE 3094-11 Portfolio Creation

Recognizing student deficiency in career preparation, this class was created to teach design and technology students how to develop a professional portfolio. Students also learn resume skills and how to write a cover letter. Developed 2010.

Co-teaching course development: THRE 3392-01/ARTS 3392-01 Art of Fashion

In assessing the program and university goals, students needed a class to develop an awareness of historical change, diversity, and culture through fashion. This course focuses on how fashion is affected by culture, gender, class, and race. Students use their historical research to analyze historical garments and recognize the difference between historical accuracy and imaginative interpretation. Co-taught and developed with Amy Von Lintel, 2011.

Linked class course development: THRE 1310-30 Learning Community

As a part of the university's freshman experience, the Learning Community for Introduction to Theatre was added to incorporate the same learning outcomes of THRE 1310 but is linked with an Interdisciplinary Studies class. The students in Theatre 1310-30 are in the same Interdisciplinary Studies so peer relationships are fostered. This link fosters a community among the students which increases their involvement in class, raises their grades (compared to non-Learning Community sections), and increases freshman retention. Learning Communities also foster faculty relationships and create a dialogue between departments. Developed in 2007-2010.

I have formally advised many undergraduate students with majors in Costume Design and Stage Management on their portfolios, resumes and progress as theatre artists. I also supervise over thirty students per semester in the costume shop and in running wardrobe backstage.
